Call to Order

Terri opened the meeting at 2.05pm

Minutes of Vestry meeting held on October 21, 2018

 The minutes as amended to include the record of absent Vestry members, Carolyn moved to approve the minutes of October 21 2018 Vestry meeting; Holly seconded. There was no discussion and the motion was approved, with five Vestry members in favor

Agenda

 The updated agenda as emailed by Carolyn on November 15 was accepted with the addition of an item on Blessings in a Backpack (Terri)

Opening

- Terri opened with prayer and led a discussion on a poem by Mary Oliver
- Dennis is unwell and is taking a leave of absence from Vestry

Mission Field

- Halim's mission work; acting priest for Mother of the Savior Congregation - Halim
 - Halim's calling is as a Curate at CEC and as a Missionary for the Diocese to build relationships with the Arab community
 - Halim met Reverend Rani Abdulmasih, pastor of the Mother of the Savior congregation that worships at Christus Victor, just as he was transitioning to a new calling in Florida
 - With the joint blessing of Bishop Gibbs and Bishop Donald Kreiss (Lutheran Bishop), Halim is now the Acting Priest for that congregation
 - The Mother of the Savior congregation will join CEC's Thanksgiving eve service Halim presiding
 - Halim and Mother of the Savior will worship at CEC on the evening of Christmas Eve and also share a meal together

Christmas services - - Terri

- Sunday December 23 (Advent 4) there will be one service at 8am
- Christmas Eve: service with children's pageant at 5.30pm, Halim and the Mother of the Savior congregation dinner and a service at 8pm (to be confirmed), the main CEC evening service will start at 9.45pm.

• Intercultural Development - - Terri

 Terri's recent sabbatical week in Portland, Oregon focused on Intercultural development and awareness. Terri hopes to use their survey tool, and possibly apply for grant funding, to support further opportunities in the area of diversity and inclusion.

• Baptized for Life (BfL) - - Terri

- The BfL team, of Stephanie Mulkern, Darrell Donakowski, Pete Kenney and Caroline Antonuccio, plus Terri and Halim, is meeting regularly and has been participating in training webinars.
- BfL commissioning will take place during 10am service on December 2
- Terri said BfL will most likely select a project that helps congregational development

• Renaissance goals implementation teams - - Carolyn

- Terri would like to commission Renaissance teams when they have formed. Confirm if you would like to do this on December 2
- Diana commented that there seems to be overlap between the Renaissance goal #1, Deepening Spiritual Life and BfL
- Deepening Spiritual Life: Holly, Barb and Lynn will get together and develop an initial plan and approach Sue Bennett and Martha Amis about joining that team
- Diana moved to Renaissance goal #3 team Social Justice, with Michael

Commission/activity updates:

• Finance – Kevin Green

- October was overall a good month. Income was \$3,700 over budget. YTD income is \$13,000 behind budget; one of the factors in this was an incorrect budget assumption (too high) about account 406 (unpledged gifts)
- October Expenses....worship behind budget (candles and wine to come)....correction to 551
 Forum/Adult for Faithwalking. Will correct Vestry activities for Convention costs
- Parish Events and Hospitality are both overspent against full year budget. For 2019 Finance will separate supplies (Sexton) from food items
- 621 Part time custodian is under budget and is offset by Grounds Service (as approved at the September 23rd Vestry meeting)
- The 'Contra' items are the Diocesan reimbursement for Curate costs
- YTD actual deficit is \$35,751 vs YTD budgeted deficit of \$33,013
- Finance will move some cash from the Comerica checking account to Ford Interest Advantage to take advantage of the higher interest rate
- Corrections have been made to the Curate discretionary Dedicated Account, which is now reinstated to the correct amount

2019 Budget - - Kevin Green

- Pledges (estimates of giving) are projecting to be below last year (\$237k) at \$223k (\$14k lower)
- Some expenses will increase in 2019 compared with 2018: medical insurance, Curate expenses, adding organist and choirmaster
- o It is likely that the full year deficit in 2019 will be in the range \$50-\$60,000
- Funds available in the Endowment account will cover 2018 and 2019 deficits. This may extend to cover 2020 and 2021 deficits, but structural change will be required to manage CEC's financial future.
- Vestry budget review is now Saturday January 12, 2019 (9am-12pm). A Parish finance meeting will be held during Forum time on January 13; ahead of the Annual meeting on Sunday, January 27, 2019

Christian Formation -- Terri

Terri and Halim have met with Titus Matthews, Communities in Schools. This may lead to future community/school partnership and a possible forum.

Property - - Michael

Insurance paying for all repairs following the recent flood damage

• Nominations Committee - Carolyn

- Selia, Diana, Carolyn working to fill three vestry positions
- Lynn recommended trying to find younger Vestry members to balance the group. This is one of the Nominations Committee goals.
- Parish will also elect 3 delegates and 3 alternates for Diocesan Convention in October 2019
- Vacancy for vestry recording secretary, after January.

Other Business

• Review of Greenwood Renaissance Bequest: Request for Funds form - - Michael

- Carolyn commented that the draft form references other documents; this material should be readily available (e.g. Renaissance goals)
- Carolyn asked if it is possible to use the universal request for funds (previously adopted by vestry)
 - Carolyn and Michael will jointly work on a consolidated form
- Finance plans to move a major portion of monies in the Greenwood bequest to an interest bearing account. We have sufficient cash on hand for expected needs

• Giving Thanks Dinner - - Terri

- Dinner will be held 2.30-4.30pm on Sunday November 18
- Various Community groups plan to participate and each will be invited to say a few words
- Funded by a grant from the Thrivent Foundation
